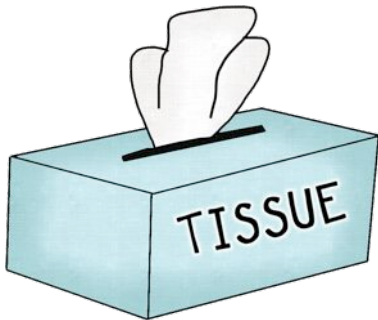

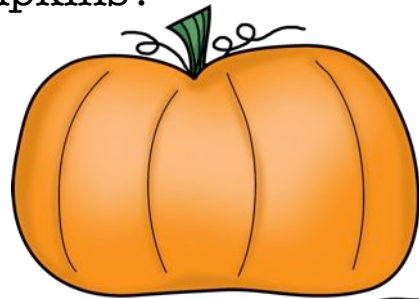
# Sick
